RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIE FEES: Each class fee is \$15. There will be a post entry fee of \$20 per class if entered after 6 pm Wednesday before the show. **No phone entries. Email to: shsfarm@aol.com. ENTRY BLANKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY THE OWNER/AUTHORIZED AGENT, RIDER & TRAINER. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK.**

AWARDS FEES: \$10.00 will be charged for every horse & rider combination and awards fee

ELIGIBILITY OF SERIES AWARDS AND RIBBONS: Riders must compete in at least 2 of 3 shows in order to be eligible for the end of series prizes. For the division to be awarded a champion or reserve awards, the division must be offered at 2 of 3 shows. There will be no end of series awards for any equitation classes.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$30.00 will be charged for all returned checks.

SCHOOLING: Sunday Ring 2 7:00 am – 8:15 am, Ring 3 7:00 am- 8:45 am.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash at all times or you are asked to leave them at home.

ATTIRE: HARD HATS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired with optional hunt coats. Riders must wear SEI approved helmets at all times while mounted on a horse. Correct rider numbers for the horse they are riding must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a Trophy and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. All Divisions will be awarded Champion & Reserve using the standard tally system: 10,7,5,3,2,1. In the event of a tie, the rider with the most points over fences will be champion, except in the jumper division, the tie will be broken by a flip of a coin.

JUMPER: Manual Poling is Prohibited for all Horses Competing in Jumper Classes.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be cancelled or combined with another division.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Prospering Farm, Inc. and Frost Bite Show officials against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of **FOOD:** Concession Stand will be open for all shows

STALLS: Limited number of stalls can be reserved on a first come basis. Stall Fee \$50 (including shavings). To reserve a stall, you must first check for availability than mail a check to Prospering Farm at 101 Equestrian Way, Prosper, TX 75078

PRIORITY RING: The one minute rule will be enforced in the Priority Ring. Please work out your conflicts ahead of time

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to show; in the Poles, riders must be in their first 12 months of riding; Walk Trot Cross Rails and Walk Trot Canter Cross Rails, riders may not have ever shown higher than 18". Riders may not cross enter into divisions with more than a 6" height difference. **WARM**

UP CLASSES: Warm Up classes are an option and do not count towards any points.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate classes. Sections with less than three entries will be cancelled. Please check the boards for changes in the schedule.

COGGINS: A current Coggins dated within the last 12 months must be shown to the show secretary for each horse shown. **EQUITATION**

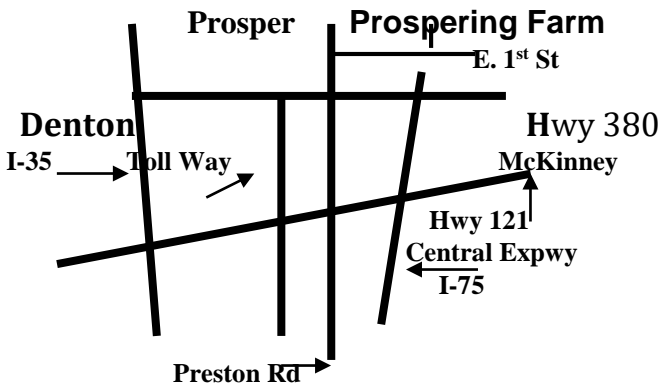
CLASSES: Equitation classes can only be entered by amateur riders only.
